First edition first printing. Two hardback books in illustrated cloth slipcase. The set is clean tight and square. Boards sharp and clean, gilt perfect. Feel very tight. Sharp spine ends. The text block is clean, with white edges. The pages are crisp and unmarked. Each book is black cloth bound, with perfect gilt titles to the spines, and a illustrated panel to the upper board. Fine condition. The slip case is likewise fine and without any issues. Overall a fine set. The publishers state this is a Limited Edition although there is no limitation page, and the publisher does not state the number of the limited edition. We obtained this set from a collector, who only viewed the book once after being given it as a gift. The set is housed in the original publishers shipping box, and has the opened shrink wrap and the insert leaflet included in the package. The insert leaflet is creased. With regard to the actual set, the slipcase is black cloth bound with a colour illustrated panel with a gilt border. Both black cloth-bound volumes have a illustrated panel to the upper board, and have 400 pages in each volume. Note that the cloth covering of both the books and the slipcase is such that it strongly attracts dust, therefore it will need to regularly be dusted to keep it looking pristine. The text charts McQuarrie's early days as an illustrator for Boeing and Apollo mission coverage through his Korean service, and mostly concerning his work with Lucas and the Star Wars creative team. The books are massive both in weight and size, measuring 12x14 inches (30x35cm) in landscape format. There are 2000 colour illustrations, all of the original artwork was rescanned for this publication, many behind the scenes photographs, production notes etc. This is a beautifully produced set, and being such a large format, the double page art spreads are amazing.
