

The Earnshaw Collection of Science Fiction and Fantasy

Thank you for taking the time to download Part two of our tenth catalogue.

The vast majority of the items in this catalogue are from the estate of Roger Earnshaw, a SF and Fantasy collector, and who was well known in SF fandom. Roger was a regular convention attendee, both in the UK and internationally. He went to many Novacons, Eastercons and Worldcons. He was known as being a generous man and supported other fans via contributions to GUFF and TAFF programmes, and he also made contributions to other SF orientated fund raisers.

The Earnshaw collection has a good proportion of signed titles, Roger's regular attendance at cons provided him with the opportunity to access authors both informally and at signings. Living and working in west London, Roger also had books signed at bookshop signing sessions, notably at Forbidden Planet and Foyles. Roger Earnshaw passed away April 2022. Roger's family understand how precious his books were to him, and are happy in the knowledge that his books will find new homes in other collections around the world.

As with part one, there are some fantastic books here, many uncommon in the UK. Of particular interest to collectors are the near fine run of Robert Jordan's Wheel of Time books; some signed Larry Niven titles including a lovely copy of the UK Gollancz yellow jacket Ringworld; lots of signed Zelazny key titles, and quite a few limited edition signed slip-cased volumes from both fantasy and SF authors. We are especially pleased to offer a UK first print Granada hardback of Raymond Feist's Magician, an extremely scarce hardback title.





Text block clean, with off white edges. The pages are crisp and unblemished. Feels very tight and hardly read. Near fine condition. Jacket is nice, and about 2mm undersized (as a lot of copies of this title are). It has some isolated light rubbing to front panel, and joint and spine ends. There is a small dink to the front joint. The rear white panel is clean with some gentle creasing at the top edge. Overall grades near fine. An attractive copy of this uncommon Anderson title.

The text block edges are white, the top edge has feint dustiness. Previous booksellers pencil price to FEP. The pages are crisp and clean, no creasing, spots, or tears. Feels very firmly bound and unread. Book in near fine condition. The jacket has minor rubbing to the edges and corners, and in a couple of small areas to the front panel. The spine is clean and the title bold, with a little crimping at ends. The rear panel is very nice with only a couple of fine colour break creases at the top edge. Jacket grades better than very good, and presents well in the hand. An attractive copy of this Flandry title, set in the Technic Civilization universe, tells Flandry's first encounter with Terra's foes.







Feels very firmly bound and gently read. Book in very good condition. The jacket has light rubbing to the edges, corners, and panels. The top corner of the front panel has a 5mm tear. The spine is clean and the title bold, with a little crimping at ends. The rear panel has some creasing and light rubbing. There is a 5mm tear to the top edge, with associated creasing. Jacket grades very good, however has no losses and presents well in the archival fitted cover. An attractive copy of this Flandry title, set in the Technic Civilization universe, collects the Flandry stories: The Game of Glory; A Message in Secret; and The Plague of Masters.

First edition first printing. Hardback book is tight clean and square. Boards sharp and clean, with softened corners and two puncture points to upper board, lower board clean and unmarked with the Heinemann windmill blind stamped. Title gilt perfect. Text block clean, with expected moderate age toning to edges, fore-edge has a few spots. Feels read, but is still tightly bound. Gentle bumping to head and foot of spine. Previous owners contemporary ink gift inscription date 1928 to FEP. Very good condition. Jacket has very minor losses to corners. There is creasing and rubbing to the front panel, which also has two puncture points corresponding to the marks on the upper board. At some point the jacket was torn in a number of places, particularly on the front joint, joint ends and the spine, and has been previously repaired to the verso with glued paper. The rear white panel has light marking and red staining, and there is a small loss to the head of the rear joint. Jacket grades as good condition, but maintains bold colours to panels and spine, looks complete, and presents well on the shelf. A solid copy of this very scarce, with jacket, first edition first printing title, that feels great in the hand and looks very nice on the shelf in the archival fitted cover. A well received Arthurian fantasy, the first book in the Neustrian Cycle. Uncommon in any state, and a great book for any serious collection.

Feels read, but is still tightly bound, no reading creases to spine. Previous booksellers pencil price to FEP. Neart fine condition. A near fine copy of this paperback published by Newcastle, the 1976 reissue of the first edition (1928), the second book in the Neustrian Cycle. Which was a well received Arthurian fantasy series, the first book in the Cycle, Gerfalcon was published in 1927. In the early 1970s Barringer's works were rediscovered and issued as reprints by Newcastle and later by Borgo.

Text block clean, with a touch of toning to edges, and the occasional spot. Feels gently read, and is still tightly bound. Gentle bumping to foot of spine. Previous booksellers pencil price to FEP. Near fine condition. Alas, no jacket. A beautiful jacket-less copy of this scarce, first edition first printing title. The third and final volume in a well received Arthurian fantasy, the Neustrian Cycle. Very uncommon in first printing hardback, great book for any serious collection.
